Oral Exams: May 26 - 29

As you begin to make summer plans, keep in mind the dates for oral exams (May 26—29). This is considered a regular week of school and students are required to attend oral exams.

Uniforms are to be worn by all students for orals.

The 7th and 8th grade exam will last approximately 45 minutes and will cover all subject areas taught over the course of the year. The exam for grades 9-12 will be in two parts: one Science project which will take about three hours, and a Humane Letters exam which will last about one hour (a little less for 9th and 10th graders.) Schedules will be mailed home to parents in mid-May. Students will also receive additional information during the last week of classes.



Stanford Testing: June 1 - 2

(Note: All student must wear uniforms)

Students in 7th, 8th and 9th grades are required to take the Stanford Tests. Students with last names from A-K should report to school on Monday, June 1 at 8:30 a.m. Students with last names from L-Z should report to school Tuesday, June 2 at 8:30 a.m. Testing will finish at approximately 11:30 a.m.

Please be in school ready to go at 8:30 a.m.

The test must start on time.

Spring Field Day

Please drop off and pick up students at **Lexington Diffley Athletic Complex, Eagan** (See directions below)

Dress for the day should be casual (blue jeans, shorts, T-shirts) but modest and tasteful. No short shorts, low necked T-shirts, ragged clothes, etc. **Water** will be available at the field, but you may also bring your own water bottle. **Pop** will be available for purchase during the **Pizza Lunch**. Please also consider bringing **Sunscreen**.

Earliest drop-off should be 7:50 a.m. Dismissal will be at 2 p.m. No study hall. Students must be picked up from the field by 2:30 p.m.

Drive south on Dodd Rd. to Hwy 55. Turn right on 55 to Lexington Avenue. Turn left onto Lexington and go 3½ miles to the Lexington-Diffley Athletic Complex. Drop off in North or West parking lot.

—Each item donated that does NOT sell will be held for next year's sale unless clear instructions are given that you will pick the items up at Trinity after the sale.

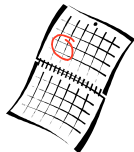
—If your item sells, you will receive a reimbursement check from Trinity as soon as possible after the sale.

From the Nurse's Office . . .

Attention Parents/Guardians of New Students

According to Minnesota State Law, students must show they have had the following shots before beginning 7th grade:

- 2nd Dose of MMR (*measles, mumps, rubella*)
- Hepatitis B Series (*3 shots*)
- Tdap (*tetanus, diphtheria, and pertussis*)
OR Td Booster (*tetanus diphtheria*)
- 2 Doses Varicella (*chicken pox vaccine*) -*the 2nd dose is a NEW requirement - or date student contracted chicken pox*



The dates of these immunizations **must** be received by **August 1st** or the student **will not** be allowed to start 7th grade. Forms were sent in late April. Please return them promptly.

Please Note: A copy of the ***signed, dated physical*** must also be sent to the athletic office.

Trinity Senior Named Merit Scholarship Winner

The National Merit Scholarship Program announced on April 22, 2009, that Trinity senior, **Jonathan Frenz**, has been awarded a corporate-sponsored *National Merit General Dynamics Scholarship*. Jonathan is one of 23 Minnesota seniors and one of only approximately 1,000 students nation-wide to receive a corporate-sponsored Merit Scholarship. Scholars were selected from students who advanced to the finalist level in the National Merit Scholarship competition and met criteria of their scholarship sponsors. Most of these awards are renewable for up to four years of college undergraduate study at any regionally accredited U.S. college or university of the student's choice. More than 1.5 million juniors in over 22,000 high schools entered the 2009 National Merit Scholarship competition when they took the 2007 Preliminary SAT/National Merit Scholarship Qualifying Test (PSAT/NMSQT). 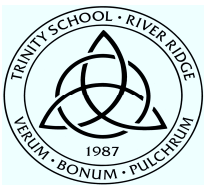

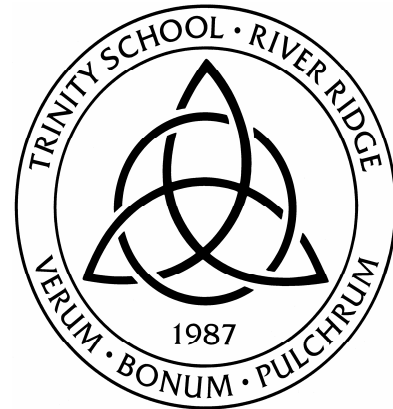
